The effect of the Order: To amend restrictions in the Borough of Colchester as follows: to replace current double yellow lines (No Waiting At Any Time) with red route 'No Stopping At Any Time' restrictions on Broman's Lane, from its junction with East Road to its junction with the access road to the country park; to introduce red route 'No Stopping At Any Time' restrictions on both sides of East Road from a point about 50 metres west of its junction with Fen Lane to a point about 60 metres north of its junction with Bromans Lane and to introduce red route 'No Stopping At Any Time' restrictions on both sides of East Road from the shared boundary of Shared Haven and Dieu Guarde in a southerly then westerly direction for 160 metres.

Statement of Reasons

East Road & Bromans Lane-East Mersea

The permanent order for the double red route restrictions is required to enhance the lines of sight for vulnerable road users, children, pedestrians and drivers alike and to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the roads by removing any form of parking regularly witnessed on site.

Double red route lines will ensure that areas such as junctions, bends and a width restricted road are protected, allowing unhindered access to all motorists, including that of larger vehicles, especially those associated with the emergency services. Parking pressures have increased and are mainly attributed to additional visitors utilising local amenities and areas of interest.
